Field Trip Newhaven Castle Hill to Black Rock Brighton

Sunday 28th July

Newhaven Start at 10am

Following the success of last year's field trip heading onto the Downs, this year we are heading to the coast to look at the Chalk. The trip will start at Castle Hill Newhaven and work along a number of stops to Black Rock Marina in Brighton. We will look at the Chalk stratigraphy, and at Newhaven its interaction with the overlying Palaeogene deposits, along the cliffs and at Brighton will look at the engineering works that have taken place at Black Rock.



Simon is a hydrogeologist with 20 years' experience and particular knowledge of the chalk geology of the South East. He also worked on the engineering site investigation for the Peacehaven waste water treatment works and associated transfer tunnel along the cliffs from Brighton to Peacehaven.

Matt is an engineering geologist with 8 years' experience and has extensive knowledge of the engineering works at Black Rock.
